# TRAFALGAR SQUARE



Trafalgar Square is one of London's great meeting places, especially in warm weather when the fountains prove a great attraction.

It commemorates the victory of the British Navy at the Naval Battle of Trafalgar.

# PARKS OF LONDON

The parks were established on lands that originally belonged to the monarchies of England and Great Britain and served as a place of recreation for the royal family. As London urbanized, parks that were preserved as an open space became accessible to residents.



# BIG BEN



Big Ben is the name of the bell located in the world-famous tower in London, the showcase of this city. The construction of the tower lasted 24 years.

It is **96.3** m high.

**334** steps lead to the observation deck located on its top.

# BUCKINGHAM PALACE

Buckingham Palace is the world's largest royal palace, which has served as the official seat of the monarch since 1837.

Buckingham Palace is the venue for state ceremonies and official meetings of heads of state.

# ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL



St. Paul's Cathedral is one of the most famous Anglican churches in the UK and the buildings of London.

Its construction was completed in 1710.

It is located in the centre of the City of London and formally serves as the main temple of this district.
